HCC's AGM and Chinese New Year Celebration


Party on 02.02.2020 HCC's Management Committee hereby announces to all full members of HCC (Chinese residents currently living in Haringey) that our annual AGM will be held on the **2nd February 2020** (Sunday), taking place at **12:30pm** at China City Russell Square. AGM's Notice letter and nomination Form will be sent out separately before 5th of January to all full members in Haringey. ***Please note: Voting in the AGM is for full members in Haringey only.** On the same day, we are also holding the Chinese New Year Celebration Party for our members. **Any FULL members** (at least 2 years membership with us) who are **75 years or above are the Priority** to receive a **FREE meal** (40 tickets); members who are **65 years or above** will be charged half price, i.e. paying **£12.50 each** (40 tickets). **Registration date** for free and half price tickets will start from **08.01.2020 at 10.30am** (first come first serve, until full).

(If you fail to attend an appointment or cancel without giving 24 hours notice, the full session fee will be applied.)

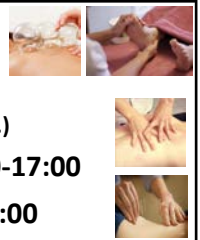
Acupuncture Service by Sam Ma: Monday 10:00-18:00, Thursday 09:30-12:00 and Friday 10:00-17:00

It allows them to clearly organise each tablet and easy to know if they have missed a session and avoid situations of taking the wrong medication. The packaging can be thrown away/dispose once finished with. If necessary, HCC will get in touch with professional chemists who can explain the use of the medication, so they can be reassured and that all their details will be kept confidential!

(1) Eastern Europe: Eight Nations 9-Days Tour - £499.00 per person (Date: 10th - 18th April 2020)

Price includes: 1. Luxury tour bus and full-time foreign driver, 2. Buffet breakfast + accommodation for three-star hotel; 3. Chinese Mandarin tour guide

Itinerary: Day 1 - London → Paris (all day) April 10th, at 08:00 meet up at outside the Costa Coffee Shop opposite the Turnpike Lane station, 08:15 departure to Dover Port, to catch up with the ferry. Crossing the English Channel, the tour guide will wait at the port of Caledon, France, and then travelled through the French countryside to Paris. After dinner, stay at the hotel and enjoy free time the first beautiful evening after arriving in continental Europe.

Day 2 - Paris → Luxembourg → Frankfurt (all day) April 11th, after breakfast then depart for Luxembourg, visit the city's Adolphe Bridge, the canyon, the Constitution Square and other attractions; then travel to Frankfurt, overnight in Frankfurt.

Day 3 - Frankfurt → Nuremberg → Prague (all day) April 12nd, travel to Prague via Nuremberg, after arriving in the afternoon, visit Prague Castle, St. Vitus Cathedral, the Golden Alley and the Charles Bridge. Cross history, trace the regional customs.

Day 4 - Prague - Bratislava - Budapest (all day) April 13th, depart for Bratislava, the capital of the Slovak Republic, then travel to Budapest, Hungary, Heroes' Square, Fisherman's Bastion, Buda Palace

Day 5 - Budapest - Vienna (all day) on April 14th, we will go to Vienna, the capital of music: Austria, and visit the famous Schoenbrunn Palace in Vienna. Subsequent tours include the Ringstraße Boulevard, Hofburg Imperial Palace, Heroes' Square, Stephen's Cathedral, Schönbrunn Palace, the National Opera, the Municipal Park, and the Austrian Parliament Building. Stay overnight in Vienna or in the neighbouring city. (Vienna is known as the "City of Music", among which the waltz is more famous. If you are interested in the evening, we can arrange for the waltz music and dance performance at your own expense.)

Day 6 - Vienna - Salzburg - Munich (all day) April 15th, go to the ancient city of Salzburg, the former residence of Mozart in the scenic Alps. Take a trip to Munich, Germany or stay in a neighbouring city.

Day 7 - Munich - Neuschwanstein - Zurich (all day) April 16th, departure to Neuschwanstein (appearance), when you have time, you can choose to buy a ticket. Then travel to Zurich, the largest city in Switzerland, and Lake Zurich, the famous glacial lake. Overnight in Zurich or nearby cities.

Day 8 - Zurich - Rhine Falls – Lake Titisee - Paris (all day) April 17th, gathers in the city of Schaffhausen to see the imposing Rhine Falls. Then ahead to the Black Forest region of Germany, the famous Lake Titisee, the production place of the Cuckoo Clock, if you are interested, we can arrange to introduce the manufacturing process of the cuckoo clock; enjoy a rich lunch or a taste of the authentic Black Forest. Eggs, drive to Paris.

Day 9 - Paris → London (all day) April 18th, after breakfast, proceed to the port of Calais. Leaving the beautiful continent of Europe, the coach ahead to London and arrives to London around 18:00-19:00 in the evening to complete the journey.

Visit beautiful Broadstairs for the first time and you could be forgiven for mistaking it for a Cornish fishing village. Forget the long drive to Cornwall and soak up the nostalgic seaside atmosphere closer to home at beautiful Broadstairs. This historic coastal town, set around the stunning sandy beach of Viking Bay, is full of character and never fails to charm its visitors.

The gorgeous, sandy beach of the horseshoe-shaped Viking Bay is ideal for family days out and is a popular place for water sports too. Home to Kent Surf School, it's common to see people surfing, kayaking and riding stand-up paddleboards here. For the children there is a safe tidal pool for when the tide has receded and a range of seasonal rides and entertainments.

With its traditional seaside feel, fish and chips go down well here and fresh seafood is on many menus. For a small place there are a surprising number of great places to eat and drink. Out-of-town big brand shopping is taken care of at Westwood Cross Shopping Centre, while the town itself leans towards little independent traders, including traditional hardware store, several art galleries, antiques shops and even has its own boutique cinema.
